Working together the children got two big logs and then some smaller strong ones to place along it, using the hand saw to cut them to size. Once they had assembled their bridge the Sunflowers then asked Emily to test the bridge first! Luckily it was built so strong that they were all able to walk across.

The mud is a perfect place to find wildlife footprints! Once they got to the wood the children found clear footprints left by some of the animals that call Wendy Wood home. They included squirrels, mice or shrews and also two different birds which the Sunflowers guessed might be blackbirds and crows.



The children also enjoyed making cooking potato cakes on the fire, searching the owl pellets to see what she had been eating and swinging between the branches.
