**To register your child at The Wendy House**

If you would like to visit us, please contact the Nursery Manager on 01223 208869 to arrange a suitable time, and to be given directions and access information. Places are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, strictly according to date of application.

A deposit of £250.00 is payable when booking your child into the Nursery. From this payment, £50.00 is a non-refundable registration fee (not applicable if applying for a funded only place), £100.00 will be deducted from your first invoice and £100.00 from your third invoice. The deposit is non-refundable if you then, for whatever reason, do not take up the Nursery place and fail to provide one month's notice.

We operate a minimum attendance requirement of three days per week - this does not apply when a child is accessing funded hours only. All places, whether funded, non-funded, or a combination of both, are offered subject to availability. Funded places are provided in line with statutory guidance and eligibility verification.

**STANDARD MONTHLY FEES**

Fees are payable one month in advance and are payable by Standing Order or via the Tax-Free Childcare Scheme no later than the 3<sup>rd</sup> of every month and are non-negotiable. Fees received after the 3<sup>rd</sup> of the month will incur an automatic late payment charge of £40.00.

**EARLY YEARS FUNDING**

Funded hours can be taken Monday to Friday, within the hours of 7.30 am – 6 pm, subject to availability. As detailed below, any additional hours are chargeable. Please note that a maximum of 10 funded hours may be taken on any given day.

**9 month - three year olds**

For children/families that qualify for the funding scheme for children aged between 9 months and three years.

Monthly fees for children aged nine months to three years, after Early Years Funded hours have been deducted, are shown below. These figures are solely for additional hours, and all services provided, beyond the funding entitlement – we do not charge any top up fees or place charges for food and consumables. All funded hours are charged at £0.

**Three and four year olds**

Early Years Funding provides three and four year olds with either 570 hours per annum (15 hours/week for all children) or up to 1140 hours per annum (30 hours/week), depending on eligibility.

Monthly fees for three and four year olds, after Early Years Funded hours have been deducted, are shown below. These figures are solely for additional hours, and all services provided, beyond the funded entitlement – we do not charge any top up fees or place charges for food and consumables. All funded hours are charged at £0.
